The Ronald McDonald House of Eastern North Carolina provides a temporary home away from home for families of seriously ill or injured children receiving treatment from area medical facilities.

How We Started

In 1974, the concept of the Ronald McDonald House was developed in Philadelphia by Fred Hill, a member of the Philadelphia Eagles professional football team, when he learned that his daughter, Kim, had leukemia. Along with the support from his teammates, and the local McDonald's Owner-Operators, the first Ronald McDonald House was built.

The Ronald McDonald House of Eastern North Carolina opened its doors on June 21st, 1987, as the world's 105th House. The 15,000 sq. ft., 21-bedroom "home away from home" has had 27,617 admissions since opening.

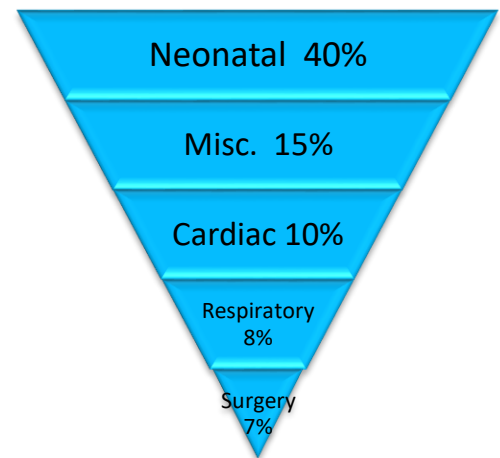

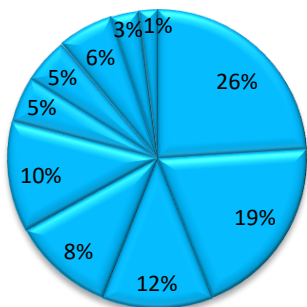

Who Can Stay

Families who:

- Have a child age 21 or younger receiving medical care in our community.
- Are referred by a social worker, care coordinator or case manager.
- RMHENC: Live at least 30 miles from the medical facility.
- RMHVMC: Have a child in an inpatient unit at VMC, short-term stays (2 to 3 nights)

How Far Your \$ Can Go

- \$10** Supports a family 1 night
- \$25** Provides cleaning supplies
- \$70** Supports a family 1 week
- \$150** Replaces bed/bath linens when needed
- \$300** Supports a family 1 month
- \$3200** Avg. monthly utility bill
- \$3650** Supports a family 1 year
